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
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
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
## *International Studies Opportunities at Lone Star College*



- Projects that connect students from diverse places using everyday technology for collaborative learning and interaction through sustained and facilitated engagement. (Aspen Institute, n.d.)







- Awarded to support and strengthen international programs and services to students








# *Turning Assignments International (Honors Research Project)*

## Before

- Students will be required to complete a semester-long research project on a **public issue** of their own choosing that has a connection to the primary focus of the course, drawing upon both library research and data you will collect through interviews or surveys.

## After

- Students will be required to complete a semester-long research project to examine the rhetoric that surrounds an **international issue** of their own choosing that has a connection to their intended major/field to study, drawing upon both library research and online data they will collect.



## *Possible Challenges*


### **Internationalized classes**

- Advisors and students need thorough information about what ISD classes are.
- Students need to understand the value of taking ISD classes and how the assignments help them meet their learning goals.

### **Virtual Exchange**

- Patience is critical to communicate with partner faculty and students and plan for VE projects.
- Time differences can make it challenging to schedule synchronous meetings.






## *Class Comments about ISD*

I found the culture-related assignments to be very interesting and thought-provoking.


In this world that has become so divided along so many lines like religion, nationality, and gender, it is more important than ever to remind ourselves that we are all still human and share one planet.


